

Scholarships Opportunities

In the light of developing its human resources, PUA enhances its graduate students and Faculty members to apply for the programs offered by The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD), PhD programs offered by the Egypt-Japan University of Science and Technology as well as the scholarships announced by the Culture Affairs and Mission Sector in the Ministry of Higher Education on its website: www.mohe-casm.edu.eg

These programs include the following:

1. **Fulbright Egyptian Scholar Program, 2011-2012** which provides opportunities for Egyptian post-doctoral faculty members, professionals, and independent scholars to conduct research at American institutions. Grant duration ranges from three to nine months. ALL fields are eligible with the EXCEPTION of dentistry. 2. **DAAD Scholarships for Egyptians (to Germany):** The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) offers various scholarships for Undergraduates, Postgraduates and Postdocs. The suitable scholarship for you depends on your current status and your specialization. If you use the link to the DAAD Homepage Bonn, Germany, you will find a scholarship database where you can search for a suitable program by using your personal criteria. 3. **The German Egyptian Research Long-Term Scholarship (GERLS).** Within the framework of the long-standing cooperation between the Arab Republic of Egypt and the Federal Republic of Germany; and in partial fulfillment of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the Arab Republic of Egypt (MHESR) and The German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) aims and objectives; the aforementioned parties have agreed to create the “German Egyptian Research Long Term Scholarships” (GERLS). Each year a group of researchers will be sent to Germany for doctoral scholarships in the scientific fields and priorities agreed upon by DAAD and MEHSR. Generally speaking, the scholarships within this program are awarded for 12 months, subject to extension up to 42 months. Candidates can select adequate structures PhD courses or PhD supervisors in Germany themselves in order to join the GERLS program. However, dual funding from universities offering such courses and the GERLS program are not permitted. DAAD Cairo Office and MHESR will support the candidates whenever necessary. 5. Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program, 2011-2012 (Professional program):

Provides mid-career professionals from Egypt and other countries with an opportunity to enhance their professional capabilities through participation in specialized, 10-month, non-degree programs developed specifically for small clusters of fellows at selected U.S. universities. To accomplish its objectives, programs include combinations of course work, independent projects, internships, consultations with U.S. faculty or experts, field trips, and special seminars. Under the guidance of a designated faculty advisor or “coordinator,” fellows plan programs that best suit their individual career development needs. For more information, please visit:
