Grading Writing Workshop Brief

Workshop Aims:

- 1. To introduce new teachers to grading techniques to use while correcting writing samples.
- 2. To introduce new teachers to correction symbols to facilitate the process of proofreading.
- 3. To make sure all teachers (old staff and new staff) are following the same criteria while correcting writing samples to avoid discrepancies in marks.
- 4. To practice applying different marking schemes on different samples of writings.

Description:

The workshop starts with dividing teachers into 7 groups. Each group has at least one new staff member. Teachers, then, get introduced to grading symbols, and why they are important to be used while correcting a writing sample. Afterwards, teachers start the practical stage getting different writing samples of different levels as well as their marking schemes. Working together, each group is asked to provide a final mark for each writing sample. In case major discrepancies occur, a discussion is conducted by which all teachers should explain their rational behind the final result they came up with. This would help in minimising discrepancies in future correction.
