Online Program

The mission of the Arabic language Center (ALC) is to teach the Arabic language to non-native speakers from all over the world. The teaching of Arabic is offered within a social and cultural context that allows students to interact with the media and literature of the contemporary Arab world.

The study program is 15 weeks, 8 teaching hours per week (120 contact hours) using the Blackboard platform.

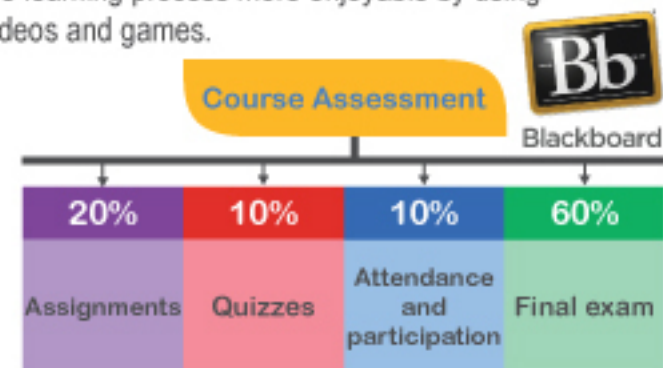
