Note that: In the 1 st week; students will be divided into 3 groups; each group of 2 students will be rotated alternatively between the three areas .	 files-area: Managing patients' files. Intermediate.area: Double checking for: Dose calculations followed by medication entry. Saving chemotherapy by minimizing the opened vials through rounding the dose by calculating the efficacy. Maintaining proper storage conditions for each chemo.agent. Storing residual chemo.for further use by checking Stability after reconstitutions & dilution (for chemo.agents that're stable after opening & reconstitution). Steps of wearing PPEs (Personal protective equipments). Mixing area: 1-sterilization of the mixing surfaces (cytotoxic cabinet) 2-Reconstitution & dilution techniques of chemo.doses into IV solns. 3-Safe waste disposal. 4- Prepare premedications. 5-Sterile packing of final chemo-regimens Patients' ward: Clinical rounds; including: patients' counseling& revising final administration instructions.
