



Policy For Minimization of Disposable Items and Different Waste Disposal

Waste disposal hazardous materials and extensions to services

There exists a system for the disposal of chemical waste at the University, where an annual contract is concluded with a company specialized in the transportation and safe disposal of hazardous chemical waste. Coordination is also made with the departments producing hazardous chemical waste to determine the type and quantities of waste extracted from the University.

A tracking statement for the disposal of hazardous chemical waste is regularly received, stating the total weight of the disposed waste at the Nasiriyah landfill affiliated to the Alexandria Governorate.

Pharos University observes cutting down on the consumption of paper by uploading all lecture notes and quality assurance papers on the University's computer application.

Plastic materials are separated from the organic waste, and they are transferred separately in the vehicles of the contracting company.

Disposable items and landfill policy

The University follows specific procedures for the disposal of total waste of extracted to document its exit from the University, whereby a special statement is then sent to the administrative director to this effect. Then, the contracting company is contacted to send vehicles to the University, and the waste is transferred to the company's vehicles by environmental affairs workers. It is stipulated that the company must be an accredited one by the Environmental Affairs Agency, the Ministry of Environment. The company transfers the waste to a private landfill for disposal.

This policy is extended to subcontractors and suppliers providing services to Pharos University.
