### Protocol on Cooperation Between PUA and Alexandria Mineral Oils Company (AMOC)

Mohammad Abdul Razaq, Director-General of the Public Administration for Chemical Labs, along with other leading staff members. The delegation was welcomed in PUA's Grand Hall by Prof. Dr. Ramadan Abu Al Ella, Vice-president for Community Services and Environment Development, Prof. Dr. Mohamed Gaber Abou Ali, Dean of the Faculty of Engineering, Prof. Dr. Gamal Behiry, Dean of the Faculty of Computer Science and Artificial Intelligence, Prof. Dr. Mohammad Yahia Al Mekki, Faculty of Engineering, as well as other faculty members of the Faculty of Engineering.
