

Scholarships to Support Students in Need

In congruence with this goal, Pharos University supported some students in- need with full scholarships, and others with waiving students' fees up to 50% depending on social assessments.

In the academic year 2022-2023, there were 111 scholarships and tuition fees waiving (Table 1) to both males and female students in almost all faculties.

According to private and confidential social assessments carried out for each student, the amount of waiving of fees is determined that ranged between 10% to 50%.
