




A Cooperation Protocol with EMPC Posted On: May 19, 2024




Corporation Protocol Between PUA and Cinemedia Posted On: April 30, 2024





Through this fair, the Faculty seeks to provide job and training opportunities for senior students, young engineers, fresh graduates, and engineers with experience in various engineering fields




The workshop addressed several important themes, including developing skills in effective communication, time management, and team






Production Printing Techniques and Post-Press Stages Posted On: May 31, 2025


